WHAT TO BRING & SUGGESTED ITEMS

The True North Helping Hands group is very fortunate; we have been blessed with a trailer and many tools. Individuals that are in the construction trade may have more personal preferences on tools.

Please ensure you all bring:

- ◇ Shoes or work Boots appropriate for a construction site.
- ◇ Work gloves. Even painters pick up and move boards.
- ◇ Any of you that have a battery operated drill should bring it.
- ◇ A water bottle.

For people that work a lot in construction you may wish to bring your own:

- ◇ Framing Hammers
- ◇ Chalk Line
- ◇ Pencils
- ◇ Utility knife with extra blades
- ◇ Swing Stapler

**** Personalize EVERYTHING

Other—This is camping style not a hotel:

- ◇ Towel & face cloth
- ◇ Sleeping bag, mattress, pillow (if in the cabin you do not need a mattress)
- ◇ Hat/sunglasses & Sunscreen
- ◇ Worksite clothes – please bring clothing that you don't plan on wearing again because even after washing, they may never get clean again (Value Village is GREAT for these types of clothing.)
- ◇ A flashlight (fresh batteries are a plus)
- ◇ Leave any valuables at home

- ◇ Your consent forms. Notarize them if the traveler is 18 or under.
