

Directions to the campground Villarino RV Park

Note: This route can only be used if you have less than \$1,000 in goods with you. This includes the cost of the tools and equipment we are bringing with us.

- 1. From San Diego take I-5 south to the border.*
- 2. After entering Mexico through customs drive in the far right lane. Once you get to the point to where traffic is merging with you from the right side, immediately start looking for a chance to move to the far right lane that just formed to your right.*
- 3. Very quickly after that is the exit to the right to Rosarito by means of the "Scenic Road" toll road to Rosarito /Ensenada. That will take you to the road that runs along the international border. Take the 1D toll road. Signs will read either the route to Ensenada or Rosarito.*
- 4. This road goes up a hill sweeps to the left and heads down hill - near the bottom you'll take the right hand exit toward Rosarito /Ensenada.*
- 5. Once you reach the coast the highway is very good and easy to follow. Rosarito is shortly after you reach the coast. Continue on 1D towards Ensenada.*
- 6. The road is good to Ensenada. As you near Ensenada the road curves along the coastline. It is a beautiful drive.*
- 7. When you reach the 'Y' in the road just out of Ensenada both sides show Ensenada. Take the right side of the 'Y'; stay closer to the coast at this point.*
- 8. Follow this road through a second 'Y' staying again to the right. This takes you through the downtown hotel area in Ensenada.*
- 9. After you pass the hotels and the large white building on the right, a museum, you will see a Naval base on your right. Turn left.*
- 10. Turn right at the Mall with Office Depot. A sign at the corner directs you south to La Bufadora and Los Cabos on Highway 1.*
- 11. Follow this road down past the Home Depot, Wall mart, and Costco.*
- 12. When you reach Maneadero watch for the sign that directs you toward La Bufadora. Take that road, which will fork to the right off of Highway 1.*
- 13. In about 10 minutes you will see the Villarino RV Park on your right. This is home for the week. They are very good to us here.*
